General Information for Pack Campouts

- The campout is not cancelled in the event of rain. We camp Rain or Shine!
- Scouts wear their PACK T-SHIRT. Adults and siblings can purchase one to wear also.
- Every scout must have an adult partner for the daytime and through the night. No drop offs.
- Scouts may have a tent of their own, but may not stay the night in a tent with an adult other than their parent.
- The scout should assist in packing and unpacking their own gear and tent. “Do Your Best!”
- Scouts **Leave No Trace**. When setting up your site, police the area for trash & other dangerous items. Also when breaking camp be sure to police the area for trash; we should leave it as good or better than we found it.
- At Pack campouts, we enjoy an evening campfire (unless there is a burn ban). Be sure to discuss fire safety with your family.
- Parents, **YOU**, not the Den Leader, are your child’s supervisor.
- Families are always welcome at Pack campouts. Siblings must be supervised by a parent.
- Each family member should have a foldable chair to sit on and a flashlight for the evening.
- The Pack will provide Saturday night dinner and Sunday morning breakfast. However, you should bring your own snacks for your family. These should be kept in a sealable container, like a cooler or Rubbermaid box. Critters get into everything.
- Bring plenty of drinking water....Water bottles in a cooler and any other extra drinks for your family.
- Be prepared with Bug spray, sunscreen and hand soap & towel, or wipes.
- **NO ELECTRONICS OF ANY KIND!**
- Bring changes of clothes; be prepared for any kind of weather – rain, cold, mud, heat.
- Feel free to bring anything you need to make yourselves comfortable. This is not meant to be a hardship. It’s supposed to be FUN!
