**Oak Point Park, Plano 9:45 am**

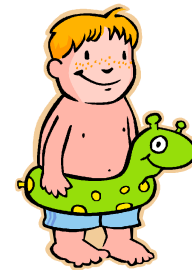
We have 2 dates scheduled so you can select the date that is best for your schedule, or do both days! Invite friends, family and neighbors to join you; the more the merrier!

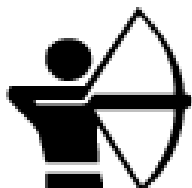
**Cub Camp 2009 \***
